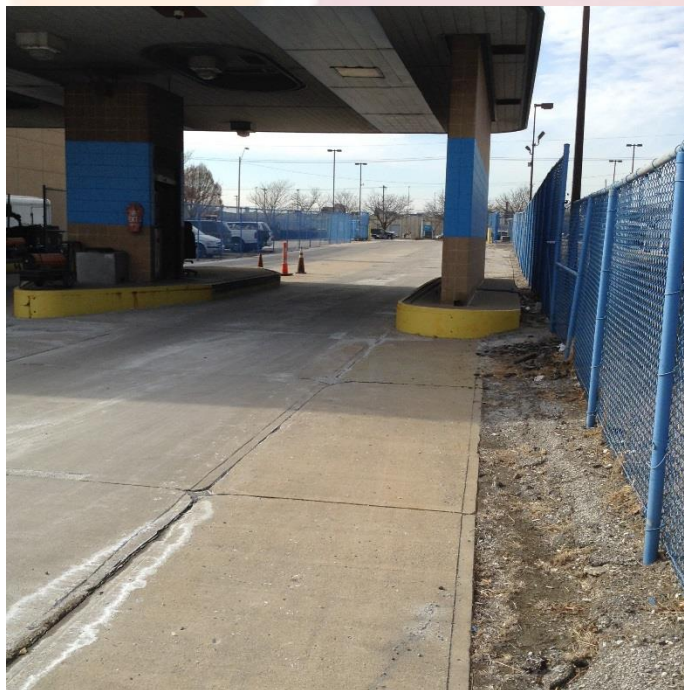




The KCATA's Central Complex has ongoing rehabilitation programs that include all of its infrastructure and facilities. As part of this effort, and as a task order under RIC's IDIQ contract, plans specifications and estimates are being produced to replace approximately 17,737 square yards of concrete pavement around eight areas of their Central Complex.

Because this is an operational facility, careful coordination for how phases around the facility were designed. RIC conducted meetings with the KCATA operations and maintenance staff to incorporate input in order to best produce phased concrete replacement plans that meet operational requirements of the KCATA. In addition to the design of the phased concrete rehabilitation, RIC collaborated with ACE Pipe Cleaning to conduct a CCTV and condition assessment of all storm sewer facilities under replacement areas to examine joints and pipe condition.

RIC continues to work with the KCATA project manager to produce plans specifications and estimates for bidding in 2015-2016 program years.
