



RIC is responsible for the design of a west entrance drive to The Bay Waterpark and the adjacent athletic facilities. RIC is responsible for survey, conceptual and final designs, and full time construction inspection on this project.

RIC's surveyors and engineers provided topographic and boundary surveys, legal descriptions, roadway design, site grading and drainage design, ADA compliance design, and utility coordination. Coordination is taking place with KC Water Services, Public Works, KCP&L and local telecom providers in order to maintain the accelerated project schedule desired by the parks department. The project includes relocation of existing power and communication lines, relocation of an existing water main, and replacements and improvements to the existing drainage system.

This project commenced in January 2015, and a design was approved in April 2015 after dialogue with Public Works, Water Services and the Southern Community Coalition. Construction documents were delivered in May 2015, allowing bidding and construction to take place over the summer. Construction, budgeted between \$400,000-\$500,000, began in September 2015 and is scheduled to be completed in January 2016.
