The public water main extension incorporates the City of Wichita's standard specifications, design criteria and standard plans including valves at appropriate junctions, hydrant sets, thrust blocking, blow off assemblies and utility crossings. The complex will be known as Greenwich Place and located at the Northeast corner of K-96 and Greenwich Road in Wichita, Kansas.
